

# FLEA TREATMENT CHECKLIST



The following items **MUST** be prepared prior to treatment. Without the proper preparations and customer cooperation, CPM cannot guarantee control of the infestation. Follow you vet's advice for treating your pets for fleas.

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## PREP LIST

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- Remove all toys, small items, and clothes from the floor, closet floors, under beds, and under furniture.
- All areas must be vacuumed, including carpet, tile and hardwood floors. Pay special attention grooves, cracks, and baseboards (especially areas frequented by pets).
- Vacuum rugs and furniture, including under cushions of upholstered furniture.
- Seal vacuum bag or contents in a plastic bag and dispose outside in a covered receptacle.
- Be sure to clean all areas frequented by pets (table tops, window sills, etc.).
- If pets spend time in basement or garage, clean floors with soap and water.
- Wash pet bedding and throw rugs to kill fleas and their eggs. Continue to wash pet bedding weekly.
- Cover all fish tanks and disconnect their air intake pumps.
- Any other birds or animals must be taken out of the house for at least 4 hours during and treatment.
- All persons must vacate the property for at least 4 hours during and after treatment.

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## AFTER THE TREATMENT

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You may see fleas for up to 2-3 weeks following treatment. Fleas that hatch following the treatment will be killed by the residual product applied.

- Vacuum all floors and baseboards 2-3 days upon completion of flea treatment and continue to do so for 2-3 weeks daily.
- Do not wash hard floor surfaces for 30 days

**Additional follow up inspections and treatments will be performed as needed.**
